

The Reverend Lynn Arthur Brown Scholarship Fund

2023 SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY and APPLICATION Trinity United Methodist Church

This scholarship was created to honor Lynn by his wife Marianne Brown for the purpose of benefitting a candidate for ordained ministry from the Washington East (WE) District, in which both Lynn and Marianne were themselves candidates. This scholarship is based neither on financial need nor on merit, as long as; the applicant is a certified candidate and has a cumulative GPA of at least 2.5. Once these criteria are met, selection will be by random drawing. In the event there are no applicants from WE, the scholarship may be awarded to any qualifying candidate from the Baltimore-Washington Conference. The scholarship is designed to assist with costs for tuition, housing, or books for the Master's of Divinity. "Tuition" is understood to include costs related to cross-cultural immersion experiences required by the school.
