2022 Scholarship Application

Eligibility Requirements

Please carefully read and review all eligibility requirements listed on

this page before starting the application process

1. The applicant has been accepted by or is attending an accredited and approved institution of higher learning.
2. The applicant cannot be a recipient of more than one Trinity UMC scholarship in the same year.
3. Applicants should be geographically located within the southern Maryland region.
4. High school graduates and current college attendees must submit official transcripts of their grades provided by the institution guidance or academic records office. Unofficial transcripts will not be accepted. The transcripts should be signed by the institution's representative, sealed and mailed or delivered to the Trinity United Methodist Church office, or, submitted electronically from the guidance counselor or academic records office to churchoffice@trinityumchurch.org by the date required below. Based on the circumstances, it is understood that returning adults may not have recent transcripts to submit.
5. On an attached sheet, provide a 1-2 page essay explaining what receiving a Trinity Scholarship would mean to you. Consider providing a statement of your faith, your relationship with the church, and/or your views on God's will for your life.
6. Please carefully review the criteria for each scholarship to determine your eligibility and also for additional requirements for submission. If you are unsure of your eligibility, be liberal in checking those for which you may think you are eligible. The Scholarship Committee reserves the right to make a final determination of eligibility.
7. All questions on the application should be answered completely and applicants are to follow the specific directions on the application form. Example, be sure to list by number and provide dates where requested.
8. No attachments such as resumes, recommendations or any other documents will be considered.
9. Completed application packages are to be returned to the Trinity United Methodist Church office electronically via email to churchoffice@trinityumchurch.org, or hard copies sent via mail or hand delivered to 90 Church St., Prince Frederick MD 20678. **The completed application and official transcripts must be received on or before 3 p.m. Friday, April 29, 2022.**
10. **Late or incomplete applications will not be considered.**
11. Applicants will be notified whether or not they are a recipient of one of the scholarships no later than Wednesday, June 1, 2022. Scholarship recipients will be recognized on Sunday, June 12, 2022 during the Trinity United Methodist Church services.

Many scholarships indicate priority will be given to “a member of Trinity United Methodist Church.” What does this mean?

Any of the scholarships indicating that the applicant must be a member of Trinity United Methodist Church refer to having received a full membership and having received a certificate of membership.

Clarifications:

- Full (professing) membership of the church involves appearing before the congregation, taking vows publicly confessing Jesus Christ as Lord while promising to serve Him and being received by the church through welcoming. When someone joins the church, they are given a Certificate of Membership.
- An infant or child baptized is considered a “preparatory member” and is not a full member.
- A baptized member who doesn't confess Jesus Christ as Lord, publicly, in a covenant service, by the age of 18, can become a “constituent” but does not have the responsibilities or privileges of a full member.
- Simply attending worship and giving financially to the church does not make one a full member.

Scholarships Requiring Trinity United Methodist Church Membership

Trinity United Methodist Church Scholarship Criteria: The applicant is (1) a student in good standing in a current graduating class in Calvert County and (2) must be an active member of Trinity United Methodist Church for the past two years.

Jay Thatcher Memorial Scholarship Criteria: The applicant (1) must be a member of Trinity United Methodist Church and (2) preference will be given to someone with a career in music.

Scholarships for Demonstrated Need, Ethnic Minorities, Future Teachers, Returning and Current Adult Students

These five scholarships are open to all Southern Maryland graduating high school seniors and college students meeting the described criteria.

Michael Andrew Cosby Memorial Scholarship Criteria: Priority will be given to an applicant who is an active member of a Christian church, active involvement in a church youth group during high school, and shows a demonstrated financial need.

W. Monnett Gott Memorial Scholarship Criteria: The scholarship must be awarded to an ethnic minority. The EEOC Guidelines for Minority Groups will be used as a reference and can be found @ <http://www.archives.gov/eo/terminology.html>.

Robert and Ruth Hall Memorial Scholarship Criteria: The applicant is a returning adult or a 3rd or 4th year college student.

Josh Medlin Memorial Scholarship Criteria: The applicant must show demonstrated need.

Barbara Weaver Memorial Scholarship Criteria: The applicant must specifically be entering in the field to become a teacher. If there are no applicants meeting the criteria, then the scholarship will not be awarded.

Trinity United Methodist Church Membership Priority

Priority is given to applicants who are Trinity UMC members. If there are no Trinity UMC members meeting the criteria, then scholarships will be awarded to non-Trinity United Methodist Church members meeting the criteria.

Alma Turner Bowen Memorial Scholarship Criteria: (1) The applicant is a member of Trinity United Methodist Church **or** actively involved in a Christian church and (2) the applicant is in good standing in a current graduating class **or** a returning college student who is a resident of Calvert County.

Philip and Joan Harper Memorial Scholarship Criteria: Priority is to be given to a member of Trinity United Methodist Church.

William H. Scrivener Memorial Scholarship Criteria: Priority is to be given to a member of Trinity United Methodist Church and the applicant is (1) a student in good standing in a current graduating class in Calvert County (2) preference is given to a student that is involved in a church youth group.

Kenneth and Roberta Van Duzer Memorial Scholarship Criteria: Priority is to be given to a member of Trinity United Methodist Church.
