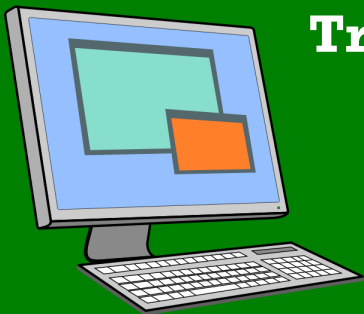

WHAT DOES THIS MEAN? It means Trinity’s Current Expenses income has gone down for the first 8 months of this year significantly. Our expenses have increased slightly, but are well under “inflationary” rises in costs (because of wise and prudent decisions of our servant leaders).

It may also mean our people, the givers who support our ministries, have been affected significantly by inflation in the cost of supplies and services, the economy and other similar distresses.

The information is to remind everyone who cares about the mission of Trinity UMC. Our ministry is driven by the faithful giving of God’s people in this church! THANK YOU FOR SUPPORTING THE MINISTRY OF JESUS CHRIST through Trinity.

SO DO NOT BE ALARMED, BUT BE INFORMED

Trinity UMC Giving Trees 2022

The Holidays are extremely difficult for families who live in poverty. As a child, I saw the agony on the faces of my Mom and Dad, knowing that without help, they could not provide Christmas for my siblings and me. Every year, we received help through Social Services, the business community and local churches. Together, they provided for us so that we could have a very Merry Christmas.



Trinity UMC provides a very Merry Christmas for many families in a similar way through the Giving Tree Ministry. Starting November 13, our three Giving Trees will be available in the Gathering Room.

1. The Tree of Angels
2. The Light in the Mountain/Roughside of the Mountain Tree
3. The Family Giving Tree

The Tree of Angels will be covered with tags that describe the child's age, gender, and a brief description of the gift requests. We ask that you try to purchase everything listed on the tag. If you are unable to purchase everything, maybe you can find another family to work with you. If you are making your purchases online, please allow extra time for shipping. Last year, there were a lot of delays with the shipping companies. There will also be a few tags on the tree requesting donations of gift-wrapping supplies, Children's Bibles and Children's Bible Story Books.

The Light in the Mountain/Roughside Giving Tree is for our Brothers and Sisters at Light in the Mountain Church in New Mexico. We are asking for \$25.00 Wal-Mart gift cards.

The Family Giving Tree is for families in our Congregation and the Local Community who are going through difficult times. We are asking for gift cards of any kind, in any amount.

The Light in the Mountain and Family Giving tree gift cards can be purchased early and dropped off in the Church Office. Otherwise, they can be placed in the boxes by the respective tree between Sunday, November 13 and Sunday, December 4. Other methods of participating in these missions include dropping off a financial donation in the Church Office designated for the tree of your choice or by specifying an amount to be contributed to the tree of your choice on your offering envelope.

All of the gifts and gift cards need to be returned to the Gathering Room by noon, Sunday, December 4, 2022.

Pancreatic Cancer Awareness: More than 61,000 Americans are expected to be diagnosed with pancreatic cancer this year. That is 166 people diagnosed every day. Pancreatic cancer is the 11th most commonly diagnosed cancer in the U.S.

A person may be more likely to get pancreatic cancer because of the following:

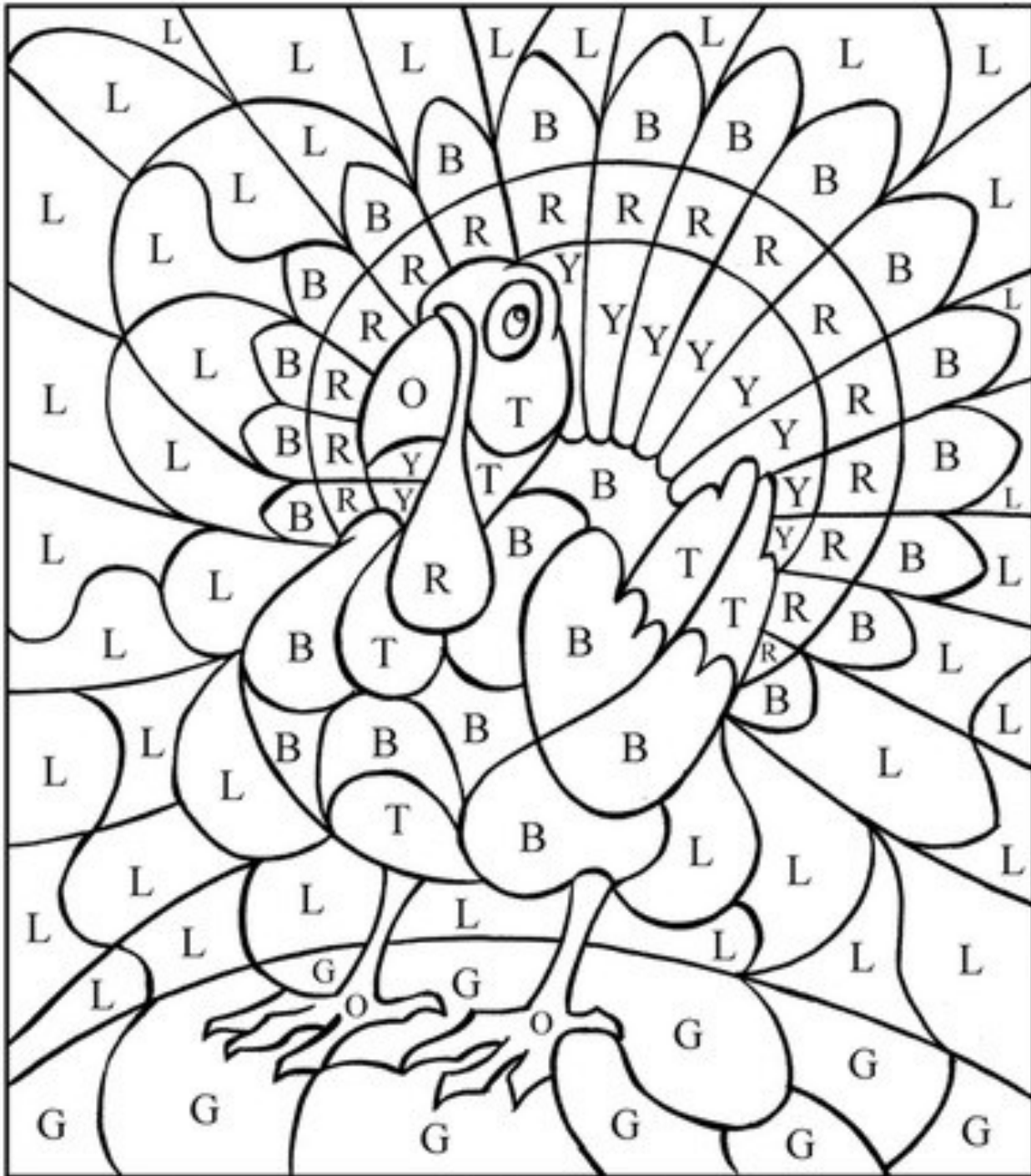
- Long-standing diabetes
- Chronic and hereditary pancreatitis
- Smoking
- Race (ethnicity): African-American or Ashkenazi Jew
- Age: over the age of 60
- Gender: males slightly more likely
- Diets high in red and processed meats
- Obesity

This does not mean that everyone who has these risk factors will get pancreatic cancer or that everyone who gets pancreatic cancer has one or more of these.
