## From the Pastor’s Pen..

*18 And when they had taken their places and were eating, Jesus said, “Truly I tell you, one of you will betray me, one who is eating with me.” Mark 14:18 (NRSV)*

*30 Jesus said to him (Peter), “Truly I tell you, this day, this very night, before the cock crows twice, you will deny me three times.” Mark 14:30 (NRSV)*

Jesus said these words on the occasion of the Last Supper, where Jesus instituted Holy Communion. In the next few hours, Judah would betray Jesus, Peter would deny even knowing Jesus, and the rest of the Jesus’ disciples would run away. All three activities were forms of betrayal of Jesus by those closest to him. They had walked and prayed with Jesus for three years, witnessing Jesus’ miracles and hearing his teachings. Yet they betrayed their friendship.

Note, Jesus loved all of them anyway and chose to spend his precious last few hours of freedom in their company, continuing to teach them verbally and by example, and pray for them. One could argue, as Peter attempted to do, that “I could never betray, deny, or flee from the presence of Jesus.” But we would be gravely mistaken. **For all have sinned and fallen short of the Glory of God.** (Romans 3:23) if you are wondering how one might discern your guilt, how many times have you broken Jesus’ Greatest Commandment to **Love the Lord our God with all your heart, soul, and mind, and love your neighbor as yourself.** (Matthew 22:37-38) Another measure of our disciples’ heart may be found in the **Beatitudes:** Matthew 5:1-11 (NRSV):

*5 When Jesus saw the crowds, he went up the mountain; and after he sat down, his disciples came to him. <sup>2</sup>Then he began to speak, and taught them, saying: <sup>3</sup>“Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven. <sup>4</sup>“Blessed are those who mourn, for they will be comforted. <sup>5</sup>“Blessed are the meek, for they will inherit the earth. <sup>6</sup>“Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they will be filled.*

*7 “Blessed are the merciful, for they will receive mercy. <sup>8</sup>“Blessed are the pure in heart, for they will see God. <sup>9</sup>“Blessed are the peacemakers, for they will be called children of God. <sup>10</sup>“Blessed are those who are persecuted for righteousness’ sake, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven. <sup>11</sup>“Blessed are you when people revile you and persecute you and utter all kinds of evil against you falsely on my account.*

Hear the Good News-Jesus chooses to love us despite our failure to live up to these expectations and to invite us to receive his Grace. Lent is an excellent time to consider areas where we must repent and seek forgiveness individually, corporately, and as a nation when we deny Jesus by failing to live up to Jesus’ expectations for us. Jesus is willing to forgive us all.

That’s the heart of what the cross and Easter is all about! Eternal life is a bonus for an earthly life well lived in light of the Way of Jesus, And God’s grace since none of us is perfect.

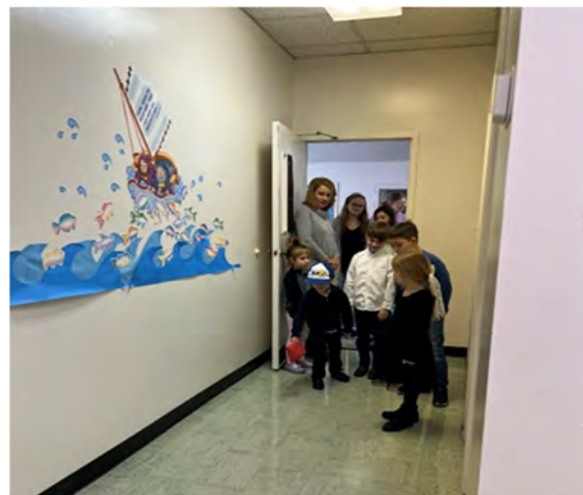

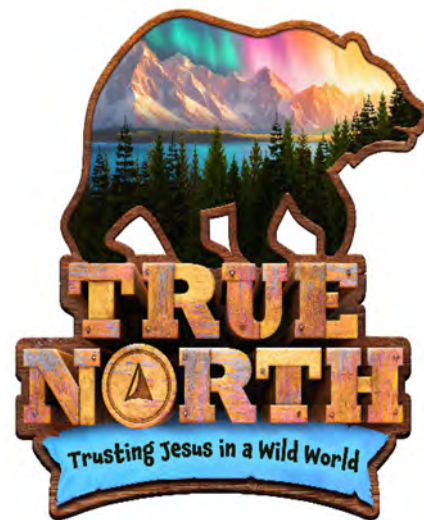

## Worship Team Message



**Then he returned to his disciples and found them sleeping. "Simon," he said to Peter, "are you asleep? Could you not keep watch for one hour? Watch and pray so that you will not fall into temptation. The spirit is willing but the flesh is weak."** Mark 14:37, 38

I am sure all of you recognize this as the exchange between Jesus and his three closest disciples Peter, James, and John in the Garden of Gethsemane just before his betrayal and arrest. He had asked them to come with him and keep him company in prayer. It was late and the flesh was tired, and they could not stay awake. Our flesh is weak, the spirit is willing and so many times the flesh wins out when the Spirit wants us to do so much more for God. Lent and our journey to the cross is more than half over. Jesus is teaching his disciples and us too that true worship goes beyond the church walls, and the limitations of the flesh. Consider this passage where Jesus told the Samaritan woman at the well about what true worship is and it is good for us to remember as well.

**"Yet a time is coming and has now come when true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and in truth, for they are the kind of worshipers the Father seeks. God is Spirit, and his worshipers must worship in Spirit and truth."**

John 4:23, 24

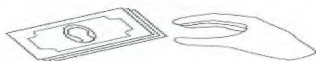
